
# Sign into Office 365 Online and setup Multifactor Authentication - iPhone

This guide will show you how to install the Microsoft Authenticator app on your mobile phone and add your Office 365 account for Multifactor Authentication (MFA).



Enter your email address and password, then click Sign in











Save password - click Never, then click Next Note: you should only save your password if this is a private computer










On your phone, open the Microsoft authenticator app and tap Scan a QR code






You might get a screen that asks you to setup an app password. If that's the case, just close the window. Then log in to portal.office.com.


