

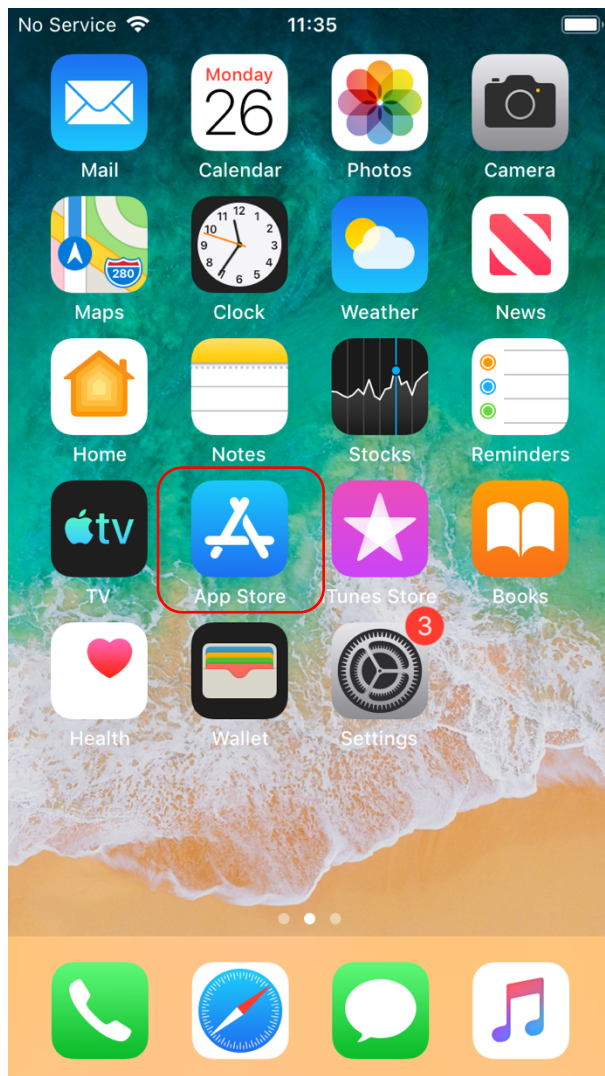
Sign into Office 365 Online and setup Multifactor Authentication - iPhone

This guide will show you how to install the Microsoft Authenticator app on your mobile phone and add your Office 365 account for Multifactor Authentication (MFA).

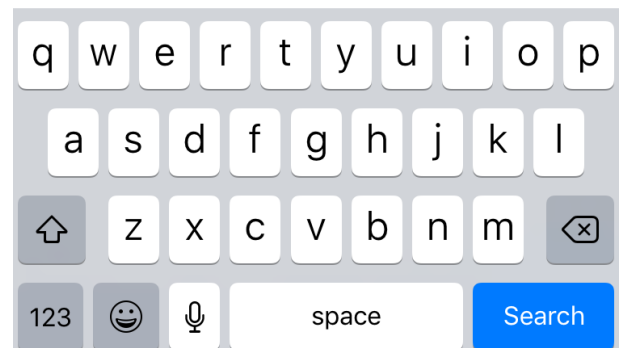
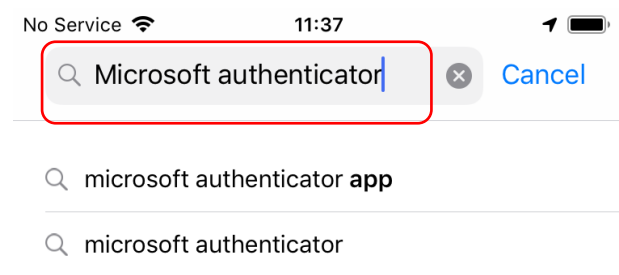
After installing the Microsoft Authenticator App on your mobile, you'll need to sign into Office 365 online <https://portal.office.com> to complete the MFA setup for your account.

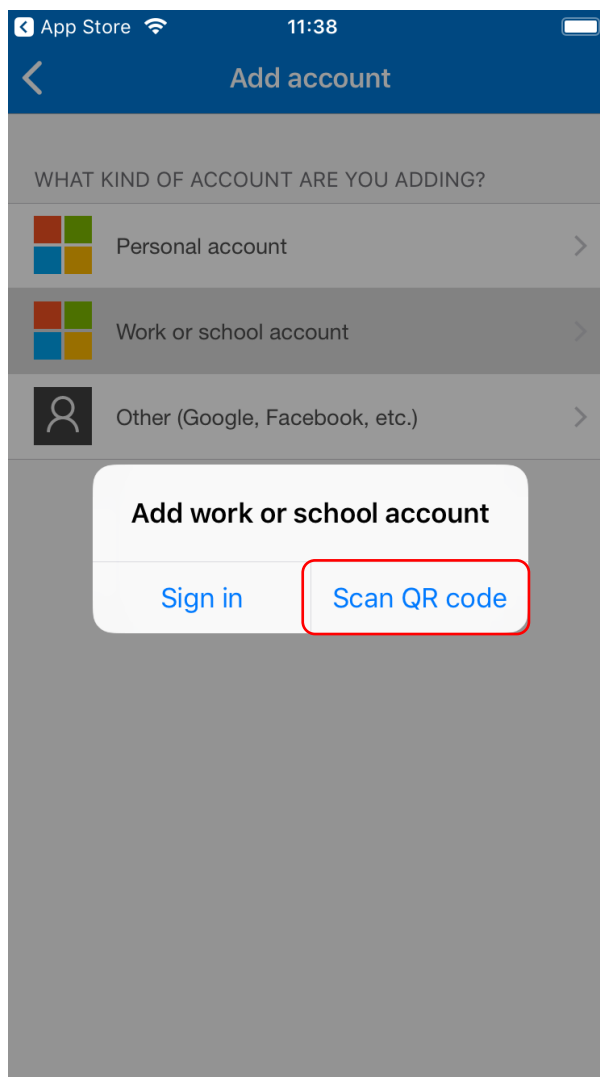
Select - Mobile app and receive notifications for verification, then click set up



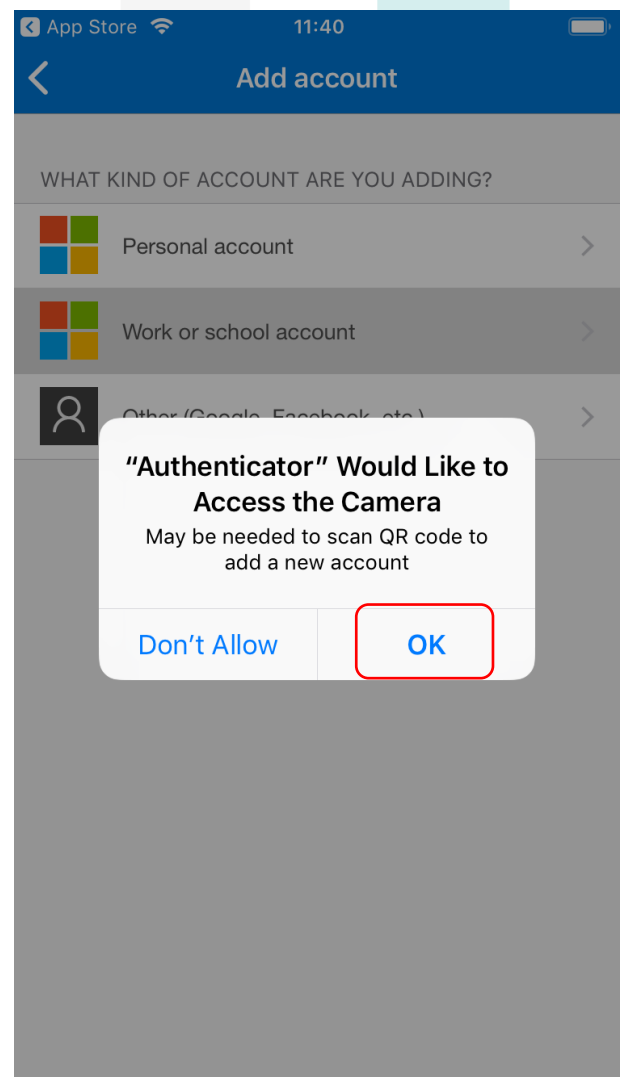
Scan the QR code using the Microsoft Authenticator app on your phone



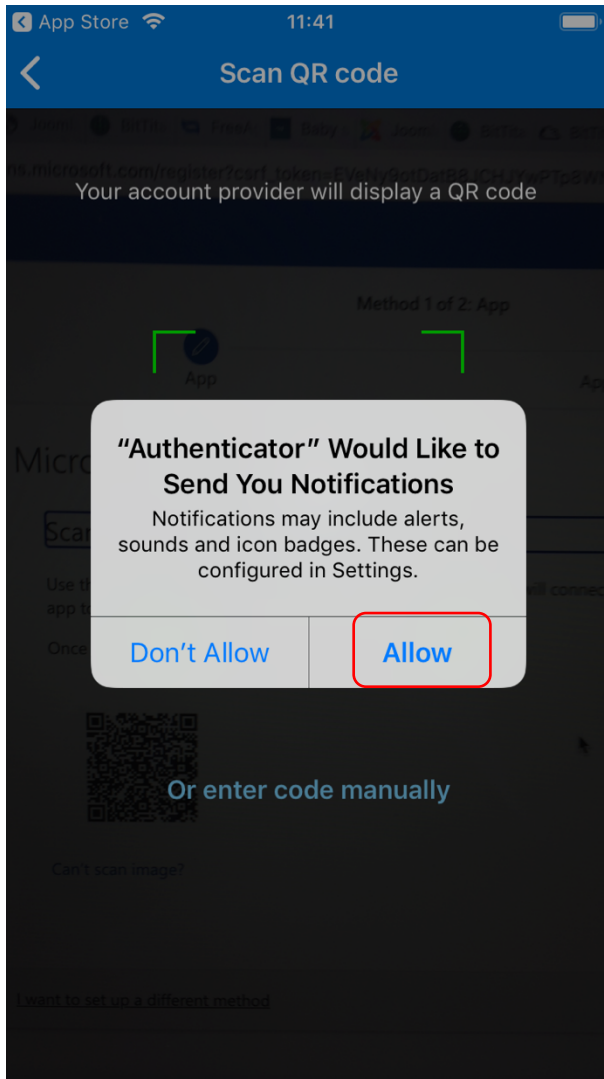
On your phone, open the Microsoft authenticator app and tap Scan a QR code



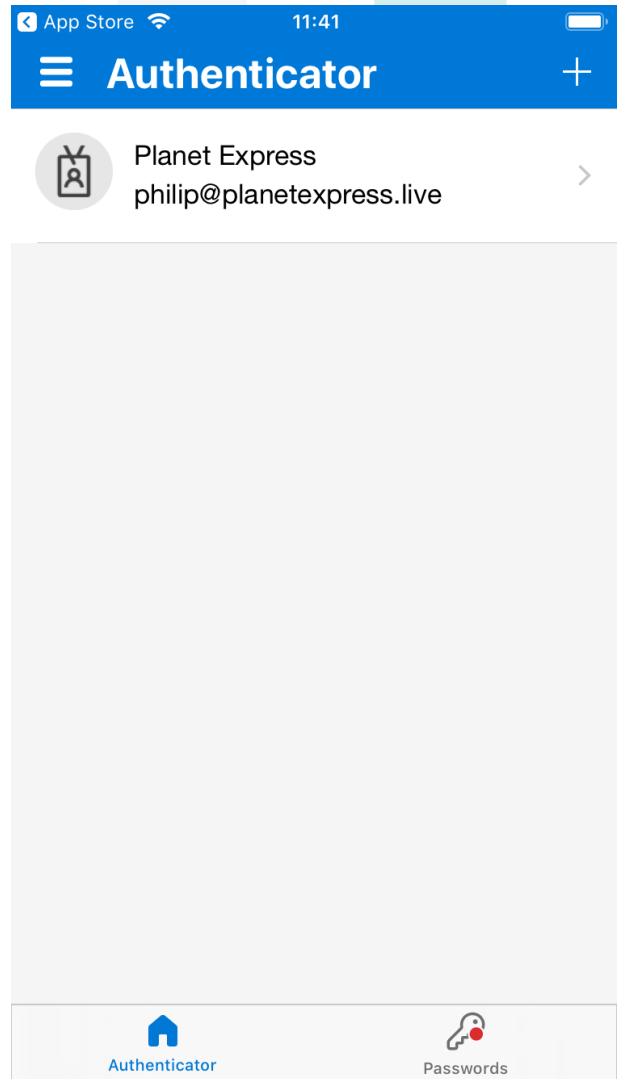

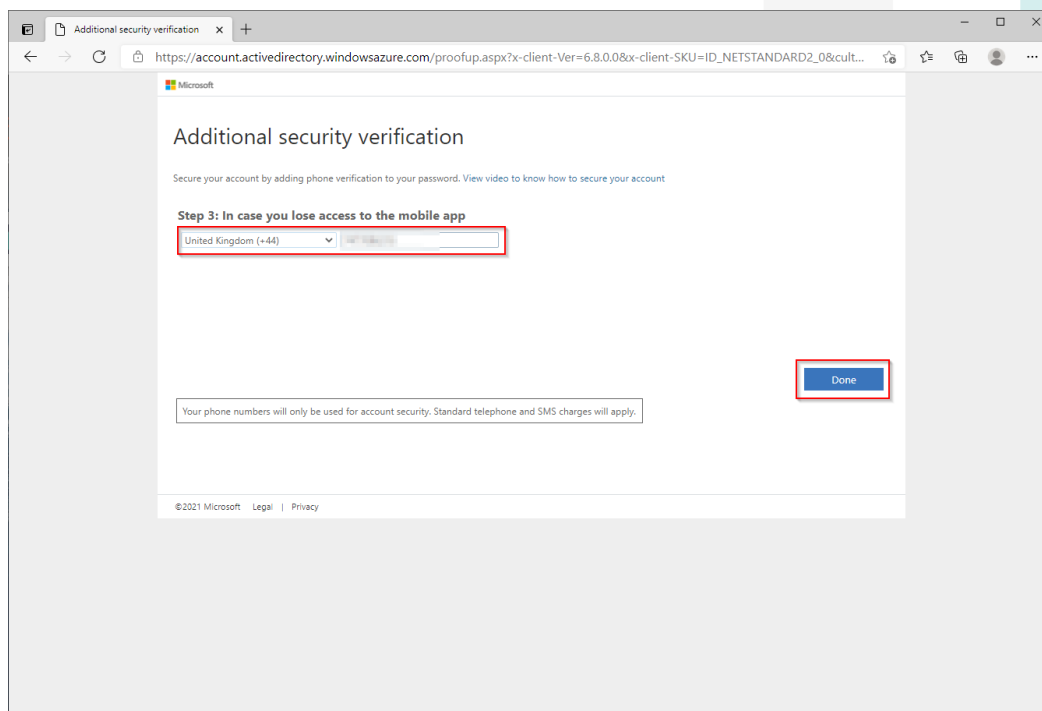




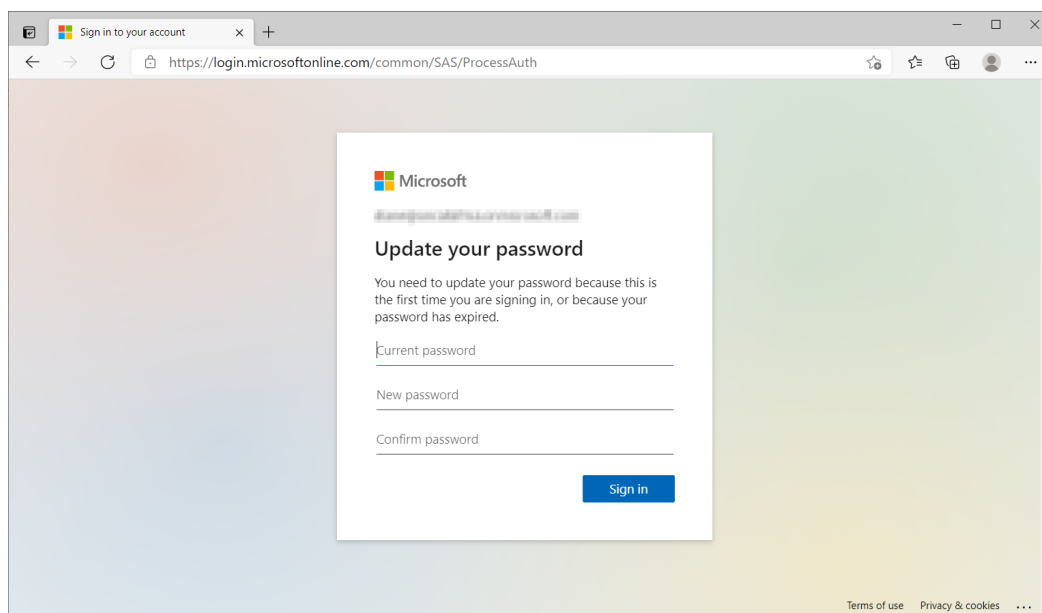
Approve the notification that pops-up in the app on your phone



Enter your mobile number then click Next



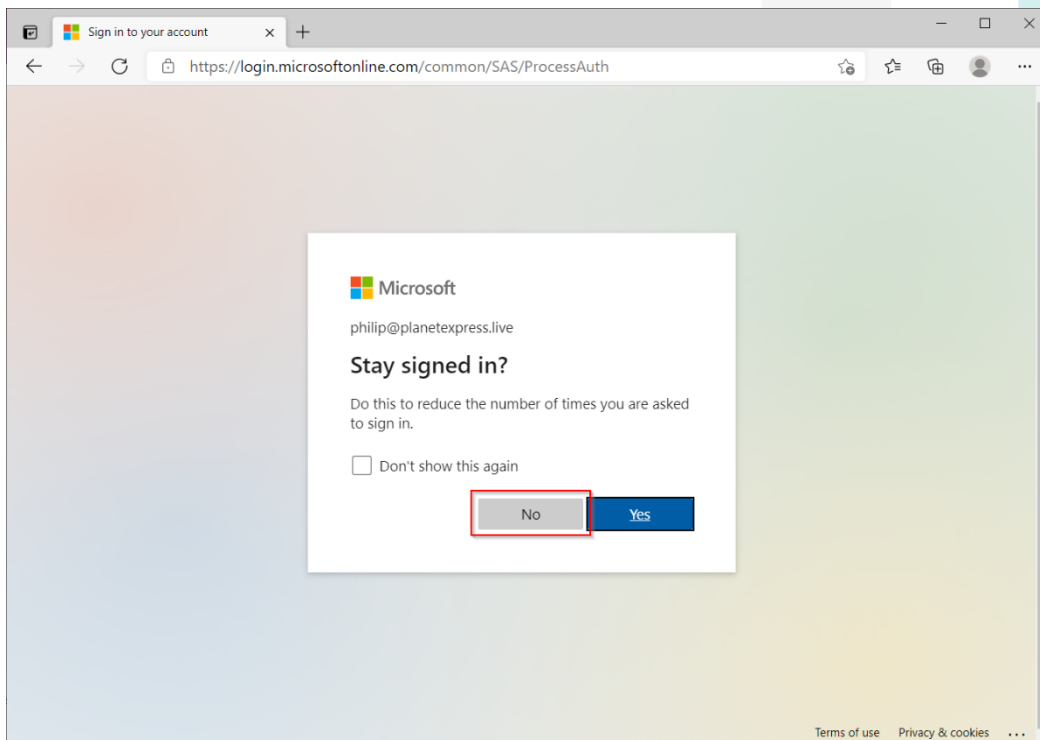

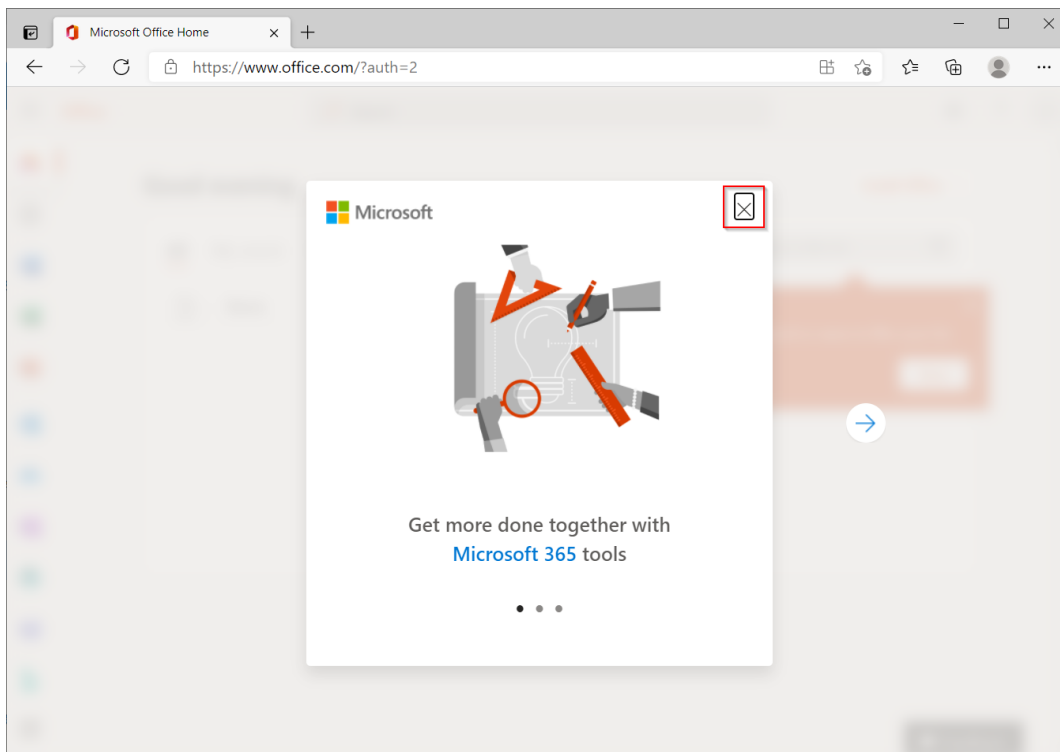
You might get a screen that asks you to setup an app password. If that's the case, just close the window. Then log in to portal.office.com.
